



The **YWCA of WNY**, in collaboration with **Enterprise Charter School**, will soon establish an after school program to be located in the Enterprise Charter School. The YWCA Extended Day Program (EDP) has been in existence in various school districts throughout the community for over 24 years. The Enterprise Charter School site will follow the New York State Department of Social Services After school care regulations and the site is fully licensed by the State of New York.

The YWCA extended day program will accept students from Buffalo Public schools, charters and catholic schools. Transportation to the Enterprise Charter School site can be provided as a secondary “child care stop”.

The private pay monthly fee for the program will vary on the amount of days the child attends per week. The YWCA also accepts the Department of Social Services (DSS) subsidy if you qualify (see table below). The extended day program provides quiet time on a daily basis for homework and/or quiet reading. Homework help is offered, books are available for every age group and reading on a daily basis is encouraged. Our after school program provides a safe and nurturing environment for those children who may otherwise be left home alone until a parent returns home from work. It is our goal to offer a relaxing, flexible, and enjoyable program, while still being a structured environment that allows children the ability to socialize with friends and children their own age.
